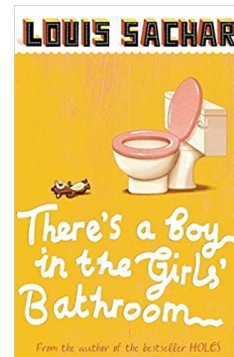

Maths

In maths, we have been perfecting our written division method and then applying this knowledge to find fractions of an amount:

$$1/7 \text{ of } 112 = 16$$
$$7 \overline{) 016}$$
$$7 \overline{) 11^1 1^4 2}$$

We then used our skills to solve word problems:

James is riding his bike so Rachel gives Sarah 2/3 of the box of pencils.
