## Maths

Recently, in maths, we have been looking at fractions and decimals. It is important that the children learn common equivalents eg;

0.1, 1/10

0.5, 5/10, 1/2

0.25, 25/100, 1/4

0.2, 2/10, 1/5

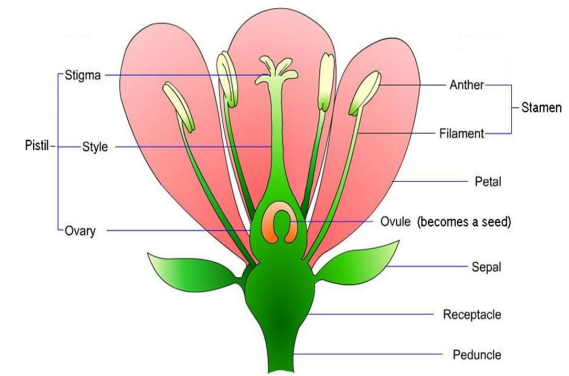
Maths Facts – Improper fractions and mixed numbers
