

What to do if...	Action needed	Return to school when...
<p>My child has Covid 19 symptoms:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • High temperature • A new, persistent cough (coughing for more than an hour, or several coughing episodes in 24 hours) • A loss of taste or smell 	<p>DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL</p> <p>Contact school to let us know.</p> <p>Self-isolate the whole household for 14 days.</p> <p>Get a test.</p> <p>Inform us immediately about a test result.</p>	<p>...the test comes back negative.</p>
<p>My child tests positive for Covid19</p>	<p>DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL</p> <p>Contact school to let us know. Agree an earliest date for possible return (minimum of 10 days).</p> <p>Self isolate the whole household for 14 days.</p> <p>Class is sent home and local health protection team contacted.</p> <p>Remote learning takes place.</p>	<p>...they feel better, (once 10 days has passed). They can return after 10 days even if they are still coughing or have no taste / smell. These symptoms can last for several weeks.</p>
<p>My child tests negative for Covid19</p>	<p>CONTACT THE SCHOOL</p>	<p>...the test comes back negative and your child feels well.</p>
<p>My child is ill with symptoms not linked to Covid 19</p>	<p>FOLLOW USUAL SCHOOL ABSENCE POLICY</p>	<p>After 48 hours following the last bout of sickness/ diarrhoea if they've had a tummy bug.</p>
<p>Someone in our household has Covid19 symptoms</p>	<p>DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL.</p> <p>Contact school.</p> <p>Arrange for the affected person to get a test.</p> <p>Self isolate the whole household for 14 days (unless the test is negative).</p>	<p>...the test comes back negative and they do not have symptoms.</p>
<p>Someone in our household tests positive for Covid19</p>	<p>DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL.</p> <p>Contact school and arrange an earliest possible date for return (14 days minimum).</p> <p>Remote learning takes place.</p>	<p>...the child has completed the 14 day period of self-isolation and they do not have symptoms.</p>
<p>NHS Test and Trace has identified my child as a close contact of someone with a confirmed case of Covid19.</p>	<p>DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL.</p> <p>Contact school and arrange an earliest possible date for return (14 days minimum).</p> <p>Remote learning takes place.</p>	<p>...the child has completed the 14 day period of self-isolation.</p>
<p>We have travelled and have to self-isolate as a period of quarantine.</p>	<p>Unless in exceptional circumstances, do not book time off in term time. Consider quarantine requirements when booking travel.</p> <p>Contact school and arrange an earliest date for return (minimum of 14 days from return date).</p>	<p>...the quarantine period has been completed.</p>
<p>We have received medical advice to resume shielding.</p>	<p>DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL.</p> <p>Contact school.</p> <p>Shield until you are informed that restrictions are lifted and shielding is paused.</p>	<p>...the shielding is paused again.</p>
<p>My child's class is closed due to a Covid19 case in school.</p>	<p>DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL.</p> <p>Remote learning takes place.</p>	<p>...school informs you that the class can return to school.</p>
