Just to let you know...

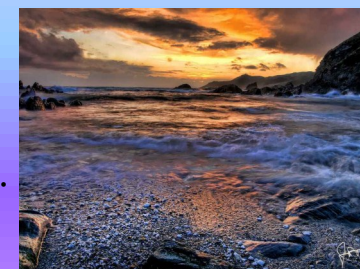
Dear Parents,
