



Curriculum News:

English:

This week in our literacy lessons we have been focussing on describing a setting. We visualised what Noah might have seen before him as he stepped off the ark after the great flood. We focussed on using adjectives for description. Maybe you could ask your child what adjectives they would use to describe something around the house!

Maths:

In maths this week we have been finishing off our work on column addition and tackling trickier problems. In the second half of the week we looked at choosing the best method for different calculations. Finally on Friday we looked at the properties of 2D shapes. Can you spot any of the shapes we talked about around your house?
