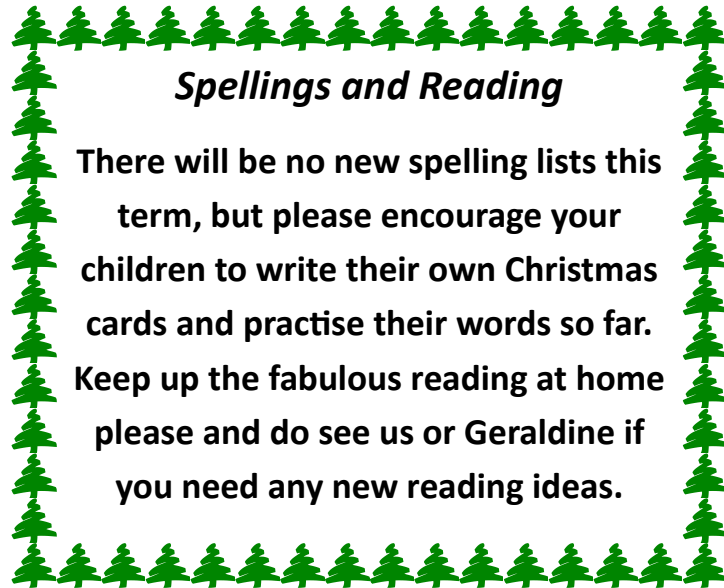


Just to Let you Know...
